Political Booth Guidelines

- 1. Each booth is limited to one issue or candidate. Candidates that want to be present in this booth must each pay a candidate fee of \$130. This is an informational, non-sales, non-fundraising booth and a free children's activity is to be provided.
- 2. Registration is \$130 per 10 ft. x 10 ft. booth space. All materials and booth staff need to stay in booth space.
- 3. Booth Hours are 10:30AM-6:00PM September 21 and 11:00AM-4:00PM on September 22, 2024.
- 4. Political booths are required to stay both days.
- 5. One (1) eight-foot table will be provided, please bring your own awning and chairs.
- 6. Booth set up is Friday, September 20, 12:00-5:00PM, Saturday, September 21, 7:00-9:30AM and Sunday, September 22, 8:00-10:00AM.
- 7. Security will be provided September 20 and 21 and Valleyfest will take reasonable precautions to protect displays. The festival will assume no responsibility for any loss due to fire, weather, theft, or other damage which might occur.
- 8. Guns, knives (including toy), generators, amplification or trailers are not allowed on site.
- 9. Compliance with county and/or state ordinance, taxes, and laws is the responsibility of participant.
- 10. Confirmation with more information will be sent out upon receipt of registration.

allows.
